NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the National Authority will apply.
- 1.3 And as amended by the Mimico Cruising Clubs' Sailing Instruction 2010

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats owned by or chartered to MCC members. Members of other Clubs may apply to the Fleet Captain for permission to enter; these will be reviewed on an individual basis.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to the Fleet Captain, before the first race they wish to enter.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Boats will not be scored until an entry form has been accepted by the Fleet Captain.

3 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

4 FEES: Note; applicable taxes apply and are in addition to the fees.

Required fees are as follows:

5 SEASON AND OVERALL SERIES

The season will consist of 3 series (Spring, Summer and Fall) and Overall series.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration: will be open from April 11th, Skippers meeting, onward.

- 6.2 Dates of racing:

<i>Series</i>	<i>Dates</i>	
Spring	May 12 - June 16	6 Races
Summer	June 23 - July 28	6 Races
Fall	Aug. 4 - Sept 8.	6 Races
Make Up Races	Sept. 11 (if required) as posted on the Race Notice Board.	

- 6.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the evening races is 6:15pm. (6pm on or after Sept. 1st)

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available April 10th, 2010 at the Skippers Meeting.

8 VENUE

Attachment A available on the windowsill outside the Manager's Office in the Club entrance hall shows the location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The course(s) shall be selected from the fixed marks, as per Attachment A, to be sailed in the order displayed on the Committee Boat and as amended by the Sailing Instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.3, will apply.

11 SCORING

11.1 The scoring system is as follows: High Point +2 (where the high point is the number of boats starting each race).

11.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a season series.

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 or 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.3 The Overall Series will be scored on the boats best 10 results (if 15 or less races scored) 12 results (if 16 or more races scored) from any season series.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. The Race Committee will monitor Channel 8. All boats are required to have a working VHF Radio on board.

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: 1/2/3 Flags for each Series and Overall Trophy's.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000.
