FAQ's:

What should I wear? Wear loose fitting clothes so you can throw and sweep the rocks with ease. Several layers will help you adjust to the temperature. A pair of gloves and a hat will help keep you warm.

What type of shoes should I wear? If you have curling shoes, that will be great. If not, running or rubber soled shoes will work well. Try to bring shoes along that haven't been worn outside. We want to keep the dirt and grit outside. Tape is available at the club to provide a sliding surface if you desire.

Do I need to bring a curling broom? No, brooms are available at the club for those who need them.

Where do I park? There are driveways at either side of the building leading back to a parking lot. The curling entrance is located near the rear of the building on the north side.

What time should I arrive? Everyone is encouraged to arrive in good time. This will make it easier to get organized, find your team, and get in some warm-up and practice time. Perhaps a beverage would be in order.

Is there a dress code at the Club? There are no dress restrictions. Common sense prevails. "Cruise" attire?

How do I pay for beverages and other items? Cash or debit is accepted.
